



Membership Terms & Conditions

Acceptance of Membership

Membership in the **Grand Junction Area Chamber of Commerce** (“the Chamber”) is available to eligible businesses, organizations, and individuals upon approval of a membership application by the Chamber’s Board of Directors. Acceptance of membership constitutes agreement to comply with the Chamber’s bylaws, policies, rules, and codes of conduct, as they may be amended from time to time, including Article III of the Amended Bylaws governing membership.

Eligibility

Membership is open to any person, association, corporation, partnership, limited liability company, trust, or estate whose application has been approved by the Board of Directors, consistent with Article III, Section 3.1 of the Chamber’s bylaws.

Dues and Member Standing

Membership dues are assessed on a calendar-year basis and may be paid annually, semi-annually, or quarterly in advance, in accordance with the dues schedule adopted by the Board of Directors. A member in good standing is current on dues and not otherwise in violation of the Chamber’s bylaws, policies, or rules.

Member Representation

Each member organization may designate an individual associated with the member to represent the organization in Chamber-related matters. Members are responsible for ensuring their representatives act in accordance with Chamber expectations and governing documents.

Use of Chamber Name and Resources

Members may reference their membership in the Grand Junction Area Chamber of Commerce but may not imply Chamber endorsement of products, services, positions, or activities without prior written authorization. Use of the Chamber’s name, logo, or brand must align with established brand guidelines and accurately reflect Chamber positions.

Code of Conduct

All members and their representatives agree to comply with the **Grand Junction Area Chamber of Commerce Member Code of Conduct**, which establishes behavioral expectations designed to protect the integrity, reputation, and effectiveness of the Chamber and its business community.

Termination of Membership

Membership may be terminated:

- Upon written resignation submitted to the Chamber;
- For failure to pay dues within ninety (90) days of the due date, unless extended for good cause; or
- By a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors for conduct unbecoming a member or conduct inconsistent with the aims or reputation of the Chamber, as provided in Article III, Section 3.8 of the bylaws.

Amendments

The Chamber reserves the right to amend these Terms & Conditions at any time. Continued membership constitutes acceptance of any amendments.
